



#### **Forever Loved: Tucker**

I love this quote from a famous Zen Buddhist Monk (who, sadly, died within the last year). And I love the idea it suggests. Does it help me face loss better? To be honest. I'm not sure.

It is true that I still "see" Tucker whenever I pass Suite G and look through the glass. He was a



magnificent presence, perched high on one of the pillars: a burly, black and white cat with an ear tip, looking proud and strong.

Tucker was one of our first FeLV+ residents. He arrived with GI lymphoma accompanying his FeLV+ status. Our original "plan" was not to provide extensive treatment for FeLV+ cats with serious diseases, as their weakened immune systems made a happy outcome unlikely.

But, Tucker was "extra spicy" in the face of his diseases, so we decided to give chemotherapy a try. While cats generally tolerate chemotherapy much better than humans, Tucker astonished us. Despite his "weakened" state, he had to be sedated to administer the drugs. And, he appeared to grow stronger with each treatment.

When his treatment ended, he was a hulk and was happy to engage in wrestling matches with his large roommate, Oram. It was incredible to witness. As usual, my mind told me he would live forever. How could any being filled with so much life possibly



But, of course, I was fooled again. After two years, his lymphoma reappeared and advanced quickly. I think the rapid progress was for the best. Tucker lived his life to the fullest until the last moment.

I have been through this many times, but it still felt like a (horrible) dream as we let him go peacefully. I'm not sure it makes it easier to bear, but I look for him each time I pass his room. Indeed, I do look deeply. I miss him every day.

The Memorial Walkway leads to Cherny's Garden, a quiet oasis of comfort. This is where the Tabby's Place staff and volunteers mourn




our own lost loved ones. We will be with you in solidarity and love – and so will the cats who gaze out from their solariums, thriving because you gave.

But at Tabby's Place, no cat's needs are too "abominable." Hummus and his extended family would become the stars on our tree.


Rescuing over fifty cats is quite an

And this December, one adorable snowman is cozy in a home all his own. Both Hummus and Salami (featured on page 1) were adopted by staff member Claudia.






### **Your Stock Can Save Lives**

The amaryllis is one of the tallest flowers, associated with strength, dignity, and determination. The word




"Amaryllis" comes from the Greek word for "to sparkle."
